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Message from the Chancellor



I am pleased to present the approved budget for fiscal year September 1, 2018 through August 31, 2019. As we persist through the final year of the College's current Strategic Plan, the One-College focus continues to be on student learning and success. During budget preparations, our strategic underlying assumptions remained solid – continue one-college alignment; optimize resources; embrace institutional research; align facilities, programming, and technologies; and promote active communication.

The College's major funding sources are ad valorem taxes, student tuition and fees, and state appropriations. The revenue generated from each of these funding sources has changed over the years. Currently, ad valorem taxes contribute 41 percent of the total unrestricted revenue budget, student tuition and fees add 35 percent, state appropriations equal 23 percent, and other local income is 1 percent. Utilizing those resources, the College administration prepared a budget designed to fund the most pressing items intended to help our students succeed. This overall increase of 3.4 percent, or \$5.6 million, in the operating budget for fiscal year 2019 will fund the following strategic initiatives:

- Net new full-time faculty positions (9)
- Market premium adjustments for high demand instructional areas
- Ongoing support for Open Books project
- New Education Planners to support Pathways and Student Success initiatives (9)
- Additional Student Services and Financial Aid positions (8)
- Instructional equipment, including audio video updates for Fine Arts venues
- Various initiatives to increase safety and security measures, both physical and online
- Continued upgrades to informational technology items and systems
- Increased costs and efforts in operational areas, including custodial services, landscaping services, insurance, marketing, and debt service
- Performance based salary increase and corresponding benefits designed to retain top performing employees

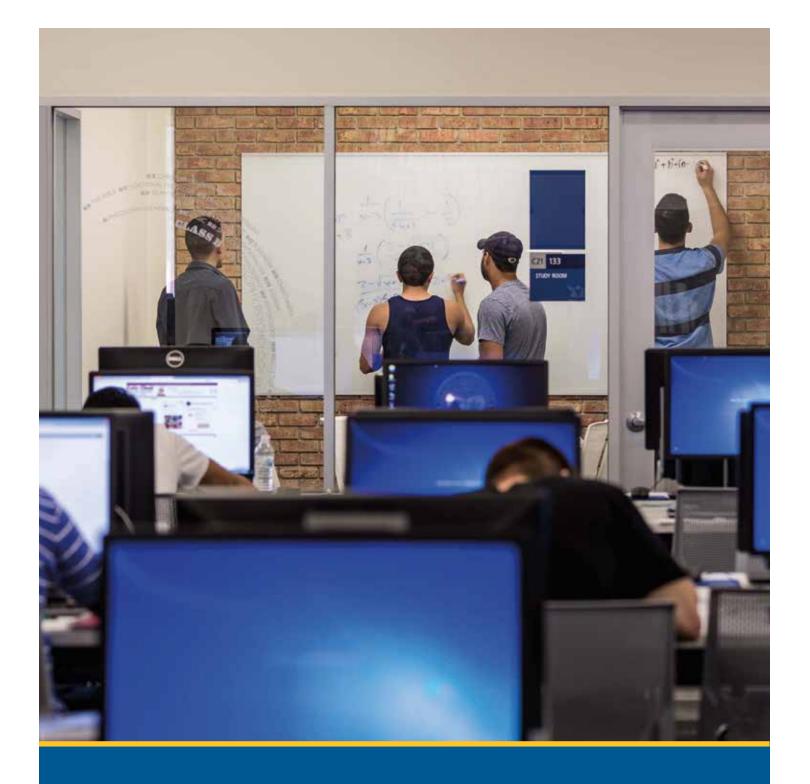
The College remains committed to being a great partner with the community and an affordable option for all students. The budget for fiscal year 2019 embraces a tax rate that is anticipated to be equal to the fiscal year 2018 rate, pending final confirmation of Harris County tax rolls. Tuition and fees will increase a minimal amount of \$2 per semester credit hour, to generate funding for the College to continue to provide and improve state of the art technology to students.

My gratitude goes to the San Jacinto College Board of Trustees for their acceptance and approval of the budget for fiscal year 2019. Also, I wish to thank the dedicated College faculty, staff, and administrators who work diligently each day to make a difference in the lives of our students.

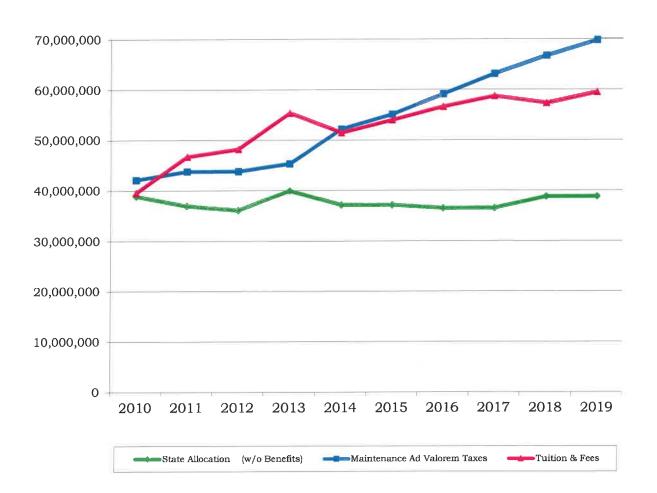
