## STEPS TO ENROLL:

San Jacinto College dual credit allows students to earn both high school and college credits simultaneously, graduating with around 24+ college credit hours and benefiting from a 75% tuition discount. Early admission, another concurrent enrollment option, does not offer the tuition discount.

### 1. Apply online and get a San Jac student ID (G#):

- Complete a profile and application at **applytexas.org**.
- Your application will be processed within 72 hours. After that, you'll receive your San Jac student ID number by email (e.g., G01001234).

### 2. Meet the Texas Success Initiative Assessment requirements:

- An exemption permanently exempts a student from taking the TSIA.
- All students must take the TSIA or prove an exemption in reading, writing, and math.
- Learn more about the **TSIA**.

### 3. Submit proof of or exemption from bacterial meningitis vaccination:

- Email shot records or exemption forms to **meningitis.docs@sjcd.edu** or fax to 281-669-4720.
- Submit your official vaccination records, exemptions, and waivers at **sanjac.edu/support/health-support/communicable-diseases/meningitis#what-to-do-next**.
- Learn more about **meningitis vaccination requirements**.

### 4. Submit Transcripts:

- Homeschool transcript **Transcript-Template.docx example**.
- Previous high school
- College/university
- AP score reports

### 5. Sign Memorandum of Understanding and Homeschool Verification Form:

*A new MOU and verification form must be signed annually.*

### 6. Register for classes:

Web registration is not available for dual credit students. To register, complete the **dual credit form**.

### 7. Pay tuition:

- Pay your portion of tuition and fees by the College's posted deadline.
- You may pay through your **My San Jac Student Portal** or in person at the College's business office. You'll need the student's ID number (G#) and password to log in. Installment plans are available.

### 8. Prepare for class:

- Get your San Jac ID card from the admissions office.
- Get your San Jac parking permit from the business office.
- Purchase textbooks from the San Jac bookstore or your preferred retailer.
- Set up and connect your **Blackboard** account.

## HOMESCHOOL ELIGIBILITY

To participate in dual credit classes as a homeschool student, you must meet these guidelines:

**Definition:** *In Texas, a homeschool is considered a private school where the primary instruction is conducted by a parent or guardian.*

1. A high school student who has not completed a GED or an alternative high school completion program
2. If the student turns 19 after the first day of classes during a semester, the student will continue as a dual credit student for the remainder of that semester. Once a student turns 19, the student's eligibility for dual credit enrollment in following semesters will cease. The student, however, may enroll in San Jac courses as a regular college student.
3. If the student earns sufficient credits for high school graduation/completion as determined by San Jac, the student's eligibility for dual credit enrollment will cease.

## HIGH SCHOOL TRANSCRIPTS

San Jac offers these guidelines to help homeschool students and their parents prepare a final transcript of their academic record:

1. School's name and address
2. Student's name
3. Student's date of birth
4. List of coursework completed with grades, dates courses taken (e.g., year, month/day, semester/year, or some combination), and credits for each course
5. Credits from other high schools. Clearly identify on the homeschool transcript or submit a separate transcript from the other high schools attended.
6. Graduation date (month and year)
7. Parent/guardian's printed or typed name
8. Parent/guardian's signature (Note: Indicate parent is signing — e.g., "Parent/Guardian \_\_\_\_\_." We reserve the right to ask for verification of parent/guardianship.)
